Dear Aircraft Owner,

Our records indicate that you are the registered owner of an aircraft based in Imperial County. Aircraft owners must file an annual Aircraft Property Statement - BOE-577 with the County Assessor. There is no e-file option for aircraft statements. However, there are two options for filing a paper property statement. You can complete the enclosed form BOE-577 or go to assessor.imperialcounty.org/forms/ to access a fillable form on the Assessor's website. To find the fillable form, go to the website forms page, click on the link to Aircraft Property Statement - BOE-577, which will take you to the Cal Assessor e-forms site and the current version of form BOE-577. When the form is completed, it can be printed, then mailed or delivered to the Assessor. If you acquired another aircraft in 2021, please complete and file a separate form BOE-577 for each aircraft that you own. You can request additional paper forms by calling (442) 265-1300 or e-mailing Assessor@co.imperial.ca.us.

Important filing instructions for Aircraft Property Statement filers:

Section I: This section must be completed or the statement will be returned to the filer.

Section II: Complete this section if you are a first time filer or if any changes occurred in 2021.

Attachments: Attach information that you feel will assist the Assessor in valuing your aircraft.

Declaration by Assessee: This section must be completed and signed. Unsigned statements will be returned. A late filing penalty may be assessed if the statement is not returned timely.

The filing dates for property statement filers are as follows:

April 1, 2022: Aircraft Property Statements are due.

May 9, 2022: Final date to file property statements without a 10% late penalty.

May 31, 2022: Last date to amend timely filed property statements without a 10% penalty.

Statements are timely filed, if postmarked by the due date.
